the spanish farm house transformation

The Dutch architect Co Govers founded the architecture studio ZEST in 2008 in Barcelona. In Spain she turned an old farmhouse into a comfortable modern home.

"The estate was old, and had the little village close by, with only a church and a couple of houses. There are written records of the place dating back a thousand years. The house was a decaying ruin. We decided to restore it combining old and modern. The old has been left viable with all its scars, while new materials such as Corten steel, wood and clay were chosen for their beauty."
